

2017 Cardboard Kayak Instructions & Rules

It's all about fun, but we still need rules. Make sure you follow 'em or you'll be DQ'd.

Divisions:

Youth Division:

9am -11am: Boat Building

11:15am – 12:15pm Race

Boat Building team consists of 6 builders, 5 of the 6 members must be under the age of 18. All crew members must be under 18 years old.

Adult Division:

1pm -3pm: Boat Building

3:15pm – 4:15pm Race

At least one crew member must be over 18 years old.

Boat Building:

- 1. Teams must register in advance. No walk-up registrations.**
- 2. Team captains should check in at the HarborFest information desk.**
- 3. Boat-building teams can have a maximum of six members. For the youth division at least 5 members must be under 18.**
- 4. The finished boat will be paddled by at least two members of the team. For the youth division all crew members must be under 18. For the adult division at least one member must be over 18.**
- 5. Boats can be constructed from supplied materials only; No other materials are allowed in the boat building area. Each team will receive: ten sheets of 5'x5' corrugated cardboard, six rolls of clear packing tape, three rolls of duct tape, utility knife, yardstick and marker**
- 6. Boat building take place from 9am-11am for the Youth Division and 1pm-3pm for the Adult Division. A paddlers meeting will be held at 11am for the Youth Division and 3pm for the Adult Division.**
- 7. The crew compartment CANNOT be enclosed so as to interfere with escape if your boat becomes a submarine! All crew members must be visible at all times during the race.**
- 8. No loose items, especially items that can get snagged on the boat or that can sink, are allowed on-board. This includes phones and cameras.**

- 9. Any costumes or decorations must be safe, buoyant and may not aid the structure or floatation of the boat. No sharp edges or pointy things!**
- 10. Boats are subject to inspection prior to the race. Boats and teams may be disqualified for violation of any of these rules.**

Crew Safety:

- 1. Crew members must sign a “Hold Harmless” waiver before the race. Crew members under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver.**
- 2. Crews will be provided paddles and life jackets. Life jackets must be worn correctly for the duration of the race. No boat will be allowed to start unless both crew are wearing a life jacket.**
- 3. All crew members must wear a PFD (Personal Floatation Device).**
- 4. Any participant thought to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be prohibited from participating in the race.**

The Race:

- 1. The race will consist of heats. The winner of each heat advances to a final race.**
- 2. Boats will paddle out and around a marker in the channel and back to the dock. Total paddling distance is approx. 50 yards. The first boat to make contact with the dock is the winner.**
- 3. During the race, the crew must be IN the boat, not towing it, swimming or allowing their life jacket to aid the boat’s floatation in any way.**
