Introduction

Stamford is a waterfront city with a rich maritime history in shipping, fishing, swimming and boating. Until fairly recently, however, the engine and working hub of the waterfront, Stamford Harbor, has been largely inaccessible by the general public. Access to the harbor was reserved for the relatively few fortunate home and boat owners or by private industry. Consequently, Stamford Harbor has been largely ignored, taken for granted and underused by Stamford residents, a risky relationship with the region's dominant natural resource.

Stamford's relationship with its harbor and with Long Island Sound beyond is beginning to change. The development of Harbor Point with its thousands of apartments and new residents has shifted an increasing segment of the population to within feet of the waterfront. Additionally, SoundWaters' impending Harbor Center project at the waterfront Boccuzzi Park, the culmination of the city's greenway connecting downtown Stamford to the waterfront, will attract residents and tourists alike to a state of the art facility for marine and environmental education and community sailing, boating and waterfront activities. ***Stamford is on the cusp of a whole new relationship with its harbor and with Long Island Sound.***

Following a successful event in 2016, which attracted over 5,000 people during the day and an additional 10,000 for fireworks, SoundWaters HarborFest is becoming Stamford's celebration of its harbor and vibrant sea shore amenities.

SoundWaters, founded in 1989, is the premier environmental education organization focused on the protection of Long Island Sound and its watershed. Annually, SoundWaters hosts shipboard and land-based programs for 32,000 children, including 11,000 from underserved communities. SoundWaters works in partnership with schools, communities, civic organizations, businesses and other environmental and educational organizations to develop experiences that foster a sense of responsibility for the environment and encourage actions that ensure the sustainable future of the Long Island Sound ecosystem. Overview of SoundWaters HarborFest 17:

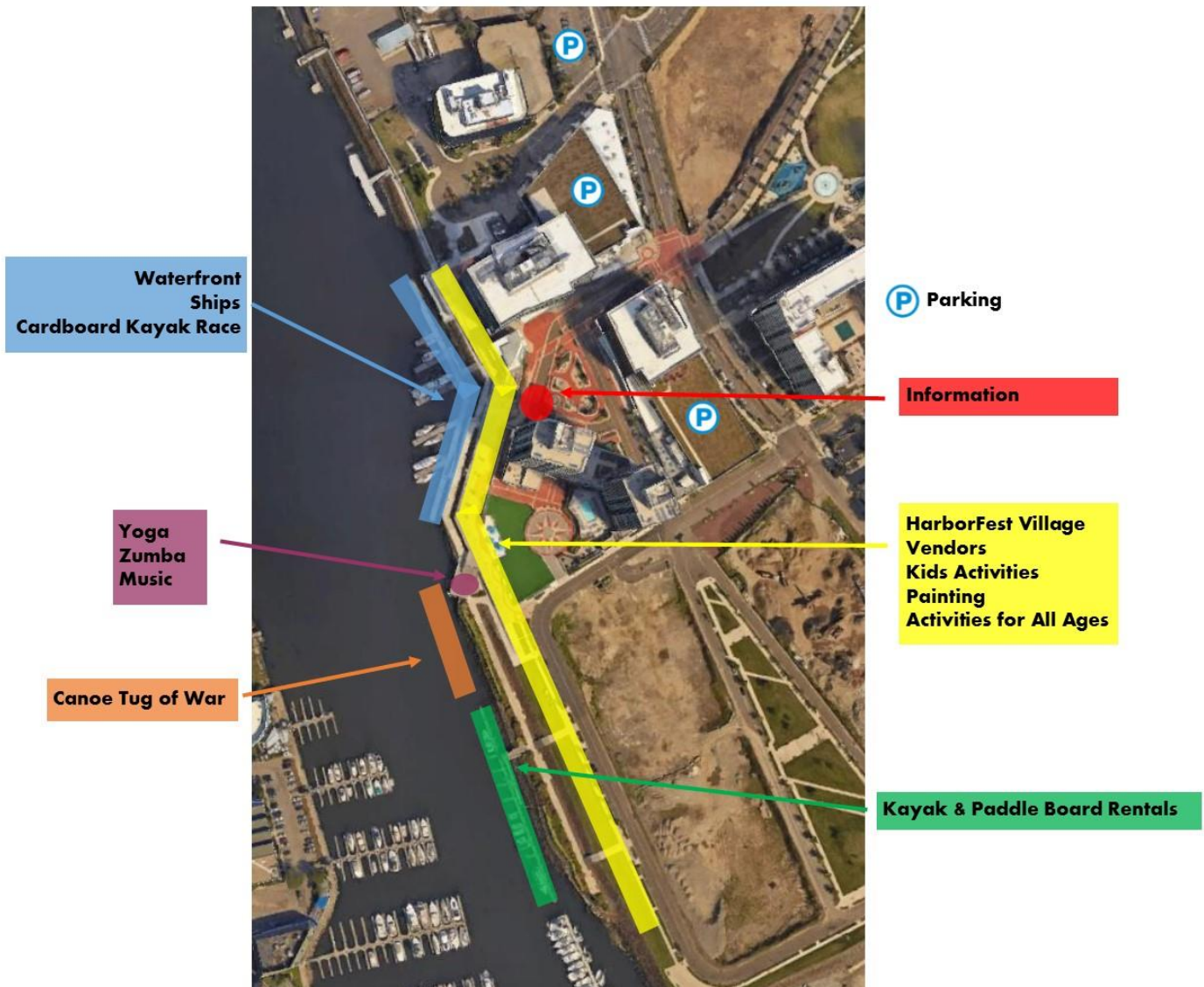
- Takes place on August 26, a peak summer weekend date
