

Cornhole Tournament Rules& Scoring


Rule 1: 1 point for bag on board. 3 points for in the hole.

Rule 2: Points cancel. For example:

Rule 3: If any part of the bag is touching the ground, it does not count.

Rule 4: Roll-ups/Bounce-ups DO count.





Preliminary & Semi Scoring: *Games are to 21 points.* Games must be won by 2 points and teams will continue playing until a winner is reached. If no winner is reached before the 30 minute time limit the team with the highest score will advance. (Single elimination). Winner from each court automatically goes through and the losing team is eliminated.

Finals Scoring: Games are to 11 points. The two teams that reach the finals will play best of 2 out of 3 games to crown the winner.

General Rules: To determine which team tosses first please use the "rock, paper, scissors" methodology. After that, the player who goes first is the one player that most recently scored. Games are single elimination. Teams should agree on the current score before starting the inning.

Teams are randomly matched up against first round opponents in a bracket format and any team to lose a game is eliminated.

The first side of contestants alternate tossing their corn bags until they have thrown all four bags, then the remaining contestants (tossing from the other cornhole platform) continue to alternate in the same manner until all four bags are delivered and the inning completed.

One contestant from each team shall be at each end of the court. When contestants are tossing their bags, the contestants at the other end shall be well behind & to the side of pitcher's box (for their own safety). The contestants pitching must be behind the front edge of the board on their side.
